HOW TO SECURE THE 2024 ELECTION AS A WORKER OR A POLL WATCHER

CALL TO ACTION

- 1. WHY ARE THESE POSITIONS IMPORTANT? WHY SHOULD YOU CARE?

In their vast wisdom, our Founders created a decentralized election system, making it much more difficult for a potential tyrant in Washington, D.C. to control elections. This is also why, *thankfully*, there is no “Federal Office of Election Security,” or similar. That is a very, very good thing! However, that does mean that **the duty to ensure our elections are honest, fair, transparent, and trustworthy fall to *we the people*.**

When radical, ideologically-driven activists who believe that the ends justify the means are the only ones with the authority to administer elections, watch the process, and take action if something is amiss, our elections will never be trustworthy.

Without patriots like you, who simply want honest elections, involved in election administration, we will always be wondering what happened when the counting stops because of a “leak...” But we can’t really complain if we didn’t make the effort to be in the room. When patriots have eyes on the process, it helps us detect any issues quickly and ensures that the polling locations are following state election laws.



In terms of priority, poll workers are the highest and most important. Below are the descriptions of each position, so that you can better understand the difference. Suffice it to say, if you were upset when poll watchers and public observers were kicked out of polling locations in 2020, and you wanted accountability that never materialized, then you instinctively understand the importance of becoming a poll worker. However, poll watchers are also necessary because the more eyes there are to report problems, the more likely the problems can be addressed before it's too late.

Finally, remember this: The only way to secure our borders, stop the weaponization of the federal government against conservatives, decrease spending, and change all of the other policies you care about, is to change who makes the policies. But we can't do that if our elections are corrupt. Just like the title states, in America it must be easy to vote, but hard to cheat. Your involvement is what makes it hard to cheat, so get involved today!

WHAT IS A POLL WORKER?

Poll workers are the people who check voters into the precinct location to vote, hand the voter their ballot or card for the ballot marking device (touch screen computer with ballot), tell the voter where to deposit the ballot in the ballot box, and close the precinct location after voting is over. In short, poll workers are officials responsible for administering and conducting an election in the local precinct. Poll workers are usually paid, and they are more likely to have the authority to take action if irregularities occur. They are allowed to speak inside the precinct, which is the first step in solving problems.

Your state may call this position one of the following titles: poll worker, election official, judge of elections, inspector of elections, judge, inspector, or some other similar title. These "poll workers" are generally hired at the county level by the permanent employees who administer the elections and maintain voter rolls. Those permanent employees may hold one of the following titles: election supervisor, election board, board of elections, board of commissioners, county supervisors, county judges, etc. The titles vary from state to state.

WHAT IS A POLL WATCHER?

A poll watcher is in the voting precinct while voters vote, silently watching and observing the election process. If the poll watcher sees irregularities, the poll watcher will report those irregularities to the entity (i.e., county political party) that assigned the poll watcher position based on the training received by that entity. Poll watchers have the authority to observe, but in no way interact with the voting process. They have no enforcement or executive authority. Poll watchers simply present the discrepancy to the entity who placed them and that entity will then take appropriate action.

HOW TO BECOME A POLL WORKER OR POLL WATCHER

Generally speaking, if you want to be a **poll worker**, you will need to reach out to the county employee(s) responsible for hiring those poll workers. To become a **poll watcher**, the county party of your choice will likely need to appoint you.
