The SAVE America Act does four things: it requires proof of citizenship to register to vote, it requires photo identification when voting, it fixes problems in current law that allow people to register to vote without proving citizenship, and it requires states to check their voter rolls against federal government records to identify non-citizens who may be registered. The bill has already passed the House of Representatives.


